Pursuant to \_\_\_\_\_ of the Ohio Revised Code and Butler County Local Rule DR 5, both \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ are required to attend the Mandatory Parent Education Class. Each party shall register for the class within **five (5)** days of the filing of the complaint with the Clerk of Courts. Each party to a divorce action and each party to a dissolution of marriage filing must complete the program within **forty-five (45)** days from the date of this order.

**The educational requirements MUST be completed prior to the final hearing.** If the class is not completed, the court will not hold the final hearing. The court may also impose other sanctions.
