

**Hazardous Material & Spill Reporting Requirements**

- Any gasoline, diesel or oil spilled into any body of water, sewer or storm drain system, creek or canal
- 25 gallons or more of gasoline or diesel on any road surface or ground
- Traffic accidents or incidents involving trucks transporting hazardous materials
- Hazmat spills or incidents at trucking company terminals or rail road yards
- Derailments or incidents involving trains transporting hazardous materials
- Transportation related spills or incidents at companies that ship hazardous materials
- Abandoned or illegally parked trucks or trailers carrying hazardous materials
- Spills or incidents involving hazardous waste transport (highway or rail)
- Release of any Extremely Hazardous Substance (EHS)
- Oil spill (includes without limitations to gasoline, petroleum, fuel oil, sludge, oil refuse, and oil mixed)
- Release of oil into the environment excluding a body of water in an amount of 25 gallons or more
- Need for a Regional County Hazardous Material Team response
- Any questionable spill, release or discharge of any hazardous materials into the environment, on the ground or in a body of water should be reported.

The verbal notification to the Fire Department, Ohio EPA and to Butler County LEPC / Emergency Management Agency shall be made within 30 minutes of knowledge of spill or release under Ohio Revised Code 3750.06.
