

PETITION FOR DISSOLUTION WITH CHILDREN

A Family Information Sheet (DR Form 729) is required.

The address and telephone numbers for the parties provided on the DR Form 729 matches the address and telephone numbers for the parties in the case caption.

Case Caption [DR 1(B)]

Parties' names

Parties' addresses. The filing party may request that their address be confidential through the filing of a motion.

Parties' telephone numbers

Jurisdiction and Venue - §3105.62 ORC

1. Jurisdiction – A statement of Jurisdiction.
2. Venue – A statement of Venue

Statement of Marriage - §3105.63 ORC

A statement of the date the parties were married.

Statement of Children

A statement of the name(s) and date(s) of birth of the child(ren) born issue of the marriage.

Jurisdiction of Child(ren): Juvenile Court or another Court

1. If Juvenile Court or another Court has jurisdiction over all of the children of the marriage, then the Petition contains a statement that all of the children are under the jurisdiction of the Juvenile Court or another Court.
2. If Juvenile Court or another Court has jurisdiction over some of the children, the Petition shall identify that child or those children by name.
3. If Juvenile Court has jurisdiction over all or some of the children, a statement that the allocation of parental rights and responsibilities, including parenting allocation and time, child support, tax exemptions and health insurance are pursuant to the Juvenile Court order and the juvenile case number is required.

Waiver of Representation

Unless both parties are represented by counsel, a statement waiving representation or an attached document waiving representation is required.

Counsel Identification

1. Counsel for First Petitioner provided their name, Supreme Court Registration Number, address and telephone number.
2. Counsel for Second Petitioner provided their name, Supreme Court Registration Number, address and telephone number.

Signatures on Petition

1. If both petitioners are represented by counsel, the Petition is signed by both attorneys.
2. If one party is represented by counsel, the Petition is signed by the attorney and the *pro se* litigant.
3. If neither party is represented by counsel, the Petition is signed by both *pro se* litigants.

Number of Copies

Two (2) copies, plus the original, of the Petition is required.

Required Documents to be submitted with Petition

Notice to Attend Mandatory Education (DR Form 628) is required.

The Guidelines for Parents Living in Different Homes (Form DR 803) is required.

A form DR201 is required.

An original IV- D application is required.

A completed DR 617 with a copy of all current health insurance cards are required, if applicable.

An Information for Parenting Proceeding Affidavit (Form DR616) was signed by either party, notarized, and attached.

An approved Separation Agreement, plus two (2) copies is required.

If the parties used shared parenting, an approved Shared Parenting Plan, plus two (2) copies is required.

If the parties used shared parenting, an approved Shared Parenting Decree, plus six (6) copies is required.

An approved Decree of Dissolution, plus six (6) copies is required.
