

HOUSES OF WORSHIP TOOLKIT RELEASED

The Ohio Emergency Management Agency is pleased to announce its release of the "[Houses of Worship: Targeted Disruption](#)" tabletop exercise toolkit. This free toolkit is designed to help all houses of worship prepare for an active aggressor situation at their facility.

The toolkit provides all necessary information and materials to easily plan for and host a tabletop exercise.

Since the Houses of Worship toolkits release on December 31, it's been downloaded over 1,200 times in 43 states.

Ohio EMA's previously released toolkits; [Mall Active Shooter](#), [Business Continuity: Disaster in the Workplace](#), and the [Higher Education Active Aggressor Tabletop Exercise Toolkit](#) have been downloaded over 1,000 times in nine countries and 42 states.

The next few toolkits to be released in 2020 will be focused on various K-12 school scenarios.


NEWLY RELEASED EXERCISE TEMPLATES

Planning for an exercise does not have to be a daunting task. Accurately planning for exercises allows stakeholders and participants to actively engage in the exercise process. Ohio EMA has created new exercise documents to assist in the planning process for exercise development and evaluation. These planning forms are intended for a wide variety of exercises.

Templates utilize the Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP) format to make a simple, yet effective way to plan and evaluate exercises. They are available for download in an editable format here:

GRANTS UPDATE – EHP 101

As sub-recipients of FEMA funds, many of you have heard the acronym EHP. An EHP is an abbreviation for an Environmental Planning and Historic Preservation review, and is an analysis done by FEMA to determine if grant projects are in compliance with environmental laws, regulations, and executive orders.

Projects that require an EHP screening form include construction, modification/renovation of existing structures, physical security enhancements, and all external changes or ground disturbances. Projects that do not require an EHP screening form include planning documents, management, administration, classroom-based training/table-top exercises. If your training or exercise requires land/water disturbance or building of temporary structures, your project must undergo an EHP review. However, if the training or exercise is taking place at a training facility that was designed to host such type of event no EHP is needed.

Virtual Instructor Led Training (VILT) Awareness Courses

Virtual Instructor Led Training (VILT) courses provide general awareness level counter-improvised explosive device (C-IED) information to a broad audience through an online virtual training experience with a live instructor. These courses enhance participants' awareness and capability to prevent, protect against, respond to, and mitigate attacks that use IEDs against people, critical infrastructure, and other soft targets. Perfect for participants with time availability constraints, and the participants can take them as stand-alone courses or they can serve as prerequisites for many of the instructor-led courses provided by the Office for Bombing Prevention (OBP).
