

Due to the retirement of a felony assistant prosecutor, the Butler County Prosecuting Attorney's Office seeks a full-time assistant prosecuting attorney. The successful candidate must be licensed to practice law in the state of Ohio in good standing and will primarily be responsible for handling grand jury presentations and adult trial felony dockets. The ability to work independently and familiarity with Ohio law are necessary. The attorney will investigate and prosecute White Collar Crimes and Crimes against the Elderly. Extensive felony trial experience is necessary in addition to some civil experience (such as a familiarity with powers of attorney, probate proceedings) and background in investigating and leading law enforcement in the investigation of financial crimes against elderly victims, businesses and individuals. The successful candidate will have an immediate case load. Cases come to the office in several ways; direct from Butler County citizens, from law enforcement and from Butler County agencies such as Adult Protective Services, Job and Family Services, and the Bureau of Workers Compensation. Long hours and excellence in work product should be expected. A motivated individual with a desire to spend their days in the courtroom and their evenings preparing for trial should apply. The position requires, in addition to experience, a dedication to prosecuting the above types of criminal offenses and ongoing victim contact. Excellent research and writing skills are a MUST. Additionally, oral advocacy skills and the ability to communicate effectively are a MUST. Salary is commensurate with experience.
