Complaint of the resident of E.High St in regard to sess pool turne same over to health board.

Arrested Olliver Moser and Thomas Abergost of LaCross Wis. at Depot these boys were runaways with out a place to go wired there fathers who came after them.

Was called to McKinley and Franklin Sts. in regard to a man drinkin to excess had a talk with thisnoaccount and ordered him to take better care of his family which he agreed to do We will have him again before long.

Was called to 309 S.Front St. in regard to husband leaving family found this man at Miami Hotel he was justdrunk and went home doing all right now.

A complaint was made to this office about a Mrs Bolser of S.B.St on invistigation found this case to be groundless as the old lady

Received a Phone call to go to 136 Chestnut St. found house full
of women and children house very dirty and neglected men all work
ing but poor managment had fathers of all in and said they were
going back to Ky. advised them to do so.

Another complaint from Geo. Shiflet's Wife had him and orderd him
to pay \$7.00 per week for the family.

one Pearl Watkins of the famous Roadhouse she wants to fill the
house up with girls and has taken this means to do so I objected
and took the matter before the Judge after some argument I con
vinced him of the folly of this plan the Judge had Shirley to see
about the home and he found out it was a proper home a Mrs. Brown
has no carector and has been advising the girl wrong I think We will
no more trouble with Dr. Allen in the future.

In company of Officer Wiesman I went to 532 Monument Ave. to inves
tigate a case of child abuse found two Greeks had two little colard
girls ages 8 & 5 years arrested Geo. Polis and Sam Tenekos for the
crime at the hearing the Judge let them off with a warning which
Mr Wiesman and myself don't think was right and Wiesman told the
Court so.

A complaint was made of Joe. Jacobs abusing his horse went down to
Lindenwald and found the horse had bit the man so bad he was bleed
ing bad took him to a Dr. who said his hip was fractiurd the
hosa was not hurt.

Received a letter from The Ohio Society in regard to one Grover
Moore this fellow had been ordered to pay Three Dollars per week
for the support of his children he failed to do so and came to
Hamilton to get out of paying but he figured wrong ordered him to

Was called to 11 & Hamilton Ave. to see a family named Thompson. the husband left on account of the wife seeing an old friend and entertaining him with the knowledge of the husband supplied the family with food till I could get word in the meantime the husband returned and went back with the family.

Henry Koehler and a boy named Spots abused Mrs O'Brein dog to the extent that I had to kill same had boys in and lectured the in regard to same.

Was called to Mr [redacted] wife in regard to the man not caring for the family told him he would have to care for them better or we would sign a warrant for him he is one of those bull heads who thinks the father is the king after some lecture he found out different and is doing better.

Visited the dog pond and seen 3 dogs put to death in a humane way. There has been a complaint made in regard to a family named Bittner at 217 Harmon Ave, cagen Squirrels after a talk with the game warden found we could do nothing as they are pets.

Our old friend Doc Steineky is in bad again stole a watch and sold same the property of his wife got the watch and returned same to his wife.

Arrested Herbert Huber of 419 Sycamore St. this fellow has no decency about him self the mother of the child being a widow entertains this fellow in the presents of the child who is 4 Years old the Judge referred the case back.

Arrested Chester Gilbaert for stealing a coat from a Street faker had him and the Judge sent him back to Ky. his home.

Mrs Stapleton the wife of Lary complained of her husband abusing her it is the same old case the police will not have any thing to do with the case I got them straightened out again but it wont last long.

Wilkins came to this office in regard to his wife miss-treating his boy on investigation found the boy was at fault in this that the boy on being corrected by the step-mother he swore at her and she hit him on the head with her open fist the child said with a tin can made him acknowledge he had told an untruth the father has ruined the boy by allowing him to do as he pleased.

Mrs Edw. Keller of S. 9. St. complains of her husband neglecting her and the children [redacted] had stayed out late at nights she said [redacted] [redacted] for the family testified in court and she did not deny that he gave her \$82.00 in the month of May the Judge dismissed the case.

Was called to 838 N. 3. St. where a dog had broken his legs in some manner had Gardner to get dog.

A.D. Powell of Cleveland Ave. threw rocks at the chickens of Frances Mc. Clennen of the same st. and broke the legs of same had him before Square Bolser who fined him \$5.00 his Atty. Wonnell took the case on error to the Common Pleas Court.

Mrs. Wm. Asbill of Ross & Franklin Sts. complains of the father run son away from home got boy and took him home with instructions to the father to be careful as he is on probation with this Society.

Mrs Richard Freeman of Williamsdale's was hurt on the Ohio Elect. R.R. and in need referred the case to the Township Trustees.

Mr Bertell of 906 Central Ave has a vicious dog which tore the nose of one of The Freckling co. horses had man in and shot the dog.

Mrs J.W. Abbott of 1963 Bennehofen Ave. complains of her husband drinking to excess saw the man and he said the wife was a nager had them both in and said they would try again.
