Was ask by Miss LeMount to invistage Mrs Hume for purpose of adopt ing child could not recomend as a good place for child.

Visited Dog Pond with Mr. Betcher and Councilman Brinker found same to be in a first class condition clean and in a good Sanitary condition, Killing by rifle shot, at back of head which is institanious .

Found horse owned by C. Adams with rope burn on hind leg ordered same taken to Dr.

Found horse with ring bone on hind hoof ordered same rested up for few days

Was called to Weigels castor shop by G. Kalaberer in regard to Dog had Tumor on rectum ordered same taken to Dr. or kill dog.
