

# ATTENTION:

## U.S. Citizens Applying or Reapplying for Medicaid

### Proof of U.S. Citizenship is now required

To get Medicaid, you must provide or cooperate with the county department of job and family services to provide one of the following:

-  U.S. Passport
-  Certificate of Naturalization (DHS Forms N-550 or N-570)
-  Certificate of U.S. Citizenship (DHS Forms N-560 or N-561)

If you do not have any of the items listed above, proof of **BIRTH AND IDENTITY** for each person applying for Medicaid must be used.

Examples of these documents include:

#### BIRTH

- U.S. Birth Certificate
- Certificate of birth abroad (Form FS-545)
- U.S. Citizen I.D. card (Form I-197 or I-179)
- Native American Tribal Document
- Final adoption decree
- Official military record of service showing a U.S. place of birth

#### IDENTITY

- Driver's license or state ID card with photo
- ID card issued by a federal, state, or local government
- U.S. military card or draft record
- School ID card with a photo
- School records (for child under 16)

Other documents can be accepted.

If you need more information or assistance getting these documents, a caseworker will assist you.

You will need to provide this information only **ONE** time.
